



Onstream Malaria Control Program

Once a new consultant has sign up to one of our client's projects the Backoffice, and the Business Manager analyze the requirements that we need to meet considering the country of assignment, and the client's regulations and preventions already in place. Our supplier SOS International keep us updated on the Malaria danger zones in the world. If the project is in such a location the consultant will receive the following:

MALARIA GUIDELINES CONSULTANTS. This is a basic guideline to create awareness about Malaria, and how to prevent it, with specifications about chemoprophylaxis, amongst others. Please refer to document.

MALARIA PREVENTION FORM. This is a form the consultant is required to fill with his/her physician, it indicated the medications that should be taken to the assignment, indicating that Onstream will provide additional medication on location. A comprehensive Malaria Kit will be provided preferably before deploying, and for sure between the first 24 hours of arriving to the assignment location.

MALARIA ATTESTATION FORM. The new consultant has to sign this form after reading it. We keep track of this with our Compliance Matrix. Please refer to both documents.

These are all pre-mobilization activities and the Backoffice keeps control through a matrix that is constantly been updated.

During the assignment we regularly check that the Malaria Kit is complete and valid, and remind our consultants about the dangers and necessary precautions for Malaria.
